I don't even find an entry of the author in the English version of 'wikipedia'. This book should be famous. It's immensely readable, I'll probably read more of her, just to hear her voice again. Outspoken, frank, clear. She knows, how to write and gave me pleasure from the first sentences onward. I didn't find the humour forced at all. Some chapters evoke horrible historic events, and I hope it's not the one in which the Germans play a murderous part, which is responsible for its not being translated into German.
