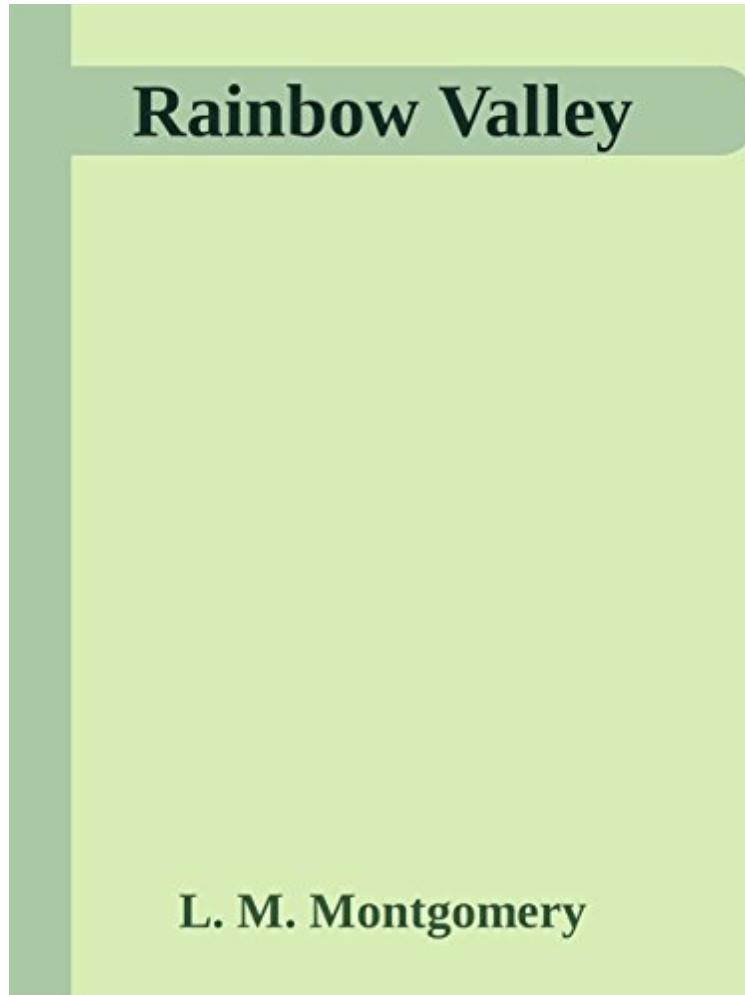

So, anyway, I enjoyed this book, but it didn't feel half as long as the earlier books, and there wasn't enough going on. Maybe I am not remembering right, but I thought there seemed to be more things happening in the rest. This one simply felt like LMM's writing, but that maybe all the bits about Anne, and basically the rest of her family, had been cut out to concentrate on the Merediths. (In the beginning of the book the publishers promise not a word has been omitted.) So yes, I enjoyed meeting the Merediths, but Anne and her family felt peripheral to the story. While the adults generally gossiped lots, none of them intervened half enough.
