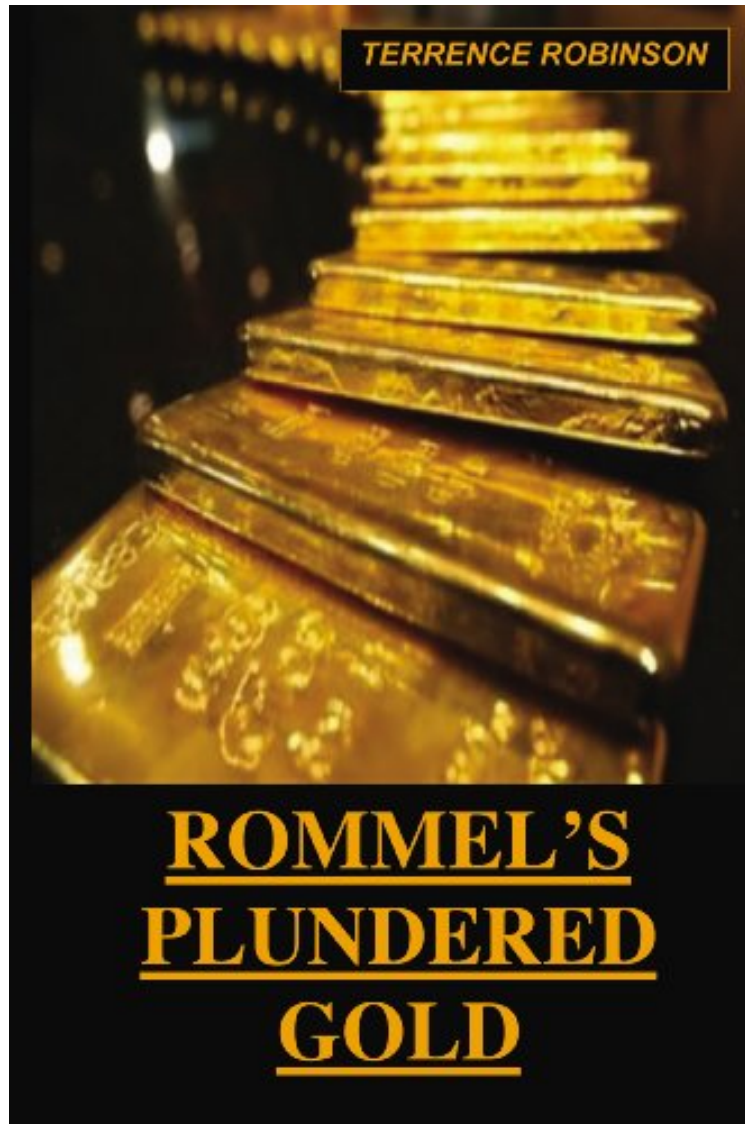

The book reads like a young student's interim examination for a creative writing course. In my view the author has cheated the reader from what in principle is a good story line, by allowing his imagination to run riot through unnecessary prose, using pages of technical manuals to describe equipment and its uses (that is really bad form - if I wanted to know the specification of a motor boat then I would look that up on the internet) and finally, some of the history is incorrect. The book has been badly researched and then written with disregard for easily recoverable fact for example : The Bundes Bank was formed about 1949 and most certainly was not around at the last stages of the war further, the Abwehr was a Naval Intelligence Service with a tri service commitment, it goes on. What was the publisher thinking or indeed doing ? It has however, renewed my optimism that anyone can have a book published and if I was daft enough to buy this then it's a winner for the author - my advice, your time and money is worth better !
